




Product Description

The SGA4463Z is a high performance SiGe HBT MMIC Amplifier. A Darlington configuration featuring one-micron emitters provides high F_T and excellent thermal performance. The heterojunction increases breakdown voltage and minimizes leakage current between junctions. Cancellation of emitter junction non-linearities results in higher suppression of intermodulation products. Only two DC-blocking capacitors, a bias resistor, and an optional RF choke are required for operation.





Noise Figure vs. Frequency













Pin	Function	Description
3	RF IN	RF input pin. This pin requires the use of an external DC-blocking capacitor chosen for the frequency of operation.
1, 2, 4, 5	GND	Connection to ground. For optimum RF performance, use via holes as close to ground leads as possible to reduce lead inductance.
6	RF OUT/BIAS	RF output and bias pin. DC voltage is present on this pin, therefor a DC-blocking capacitor is necessary for proper operation.





Evaluation Board Layout




Mounting Instructions:

- 1. Use a large ground pad area near device pins 1, 2, 4, and 5 with many plated through-holes, as shown.
- 2. We recommend 1 or 2 ounces copper. Measurements for this data sheet were made on a 31mil thick FR-4 board with 1 ounce cooper on both sides.
