Hi,

I've got a new motherboard, a new Jetway PM2MP and I'm trying to configure sound. From the Bios setup, I configured ac97 sound as "enabled" (other options are: auto or disabled). The sound chip is a VIA1617A, I tried Oss and now I'm playing with module options for the alsa module via82xx. What is strange to me is that I don't see a "Multimedia" or something line in the output of lspci. Here I paste it:
