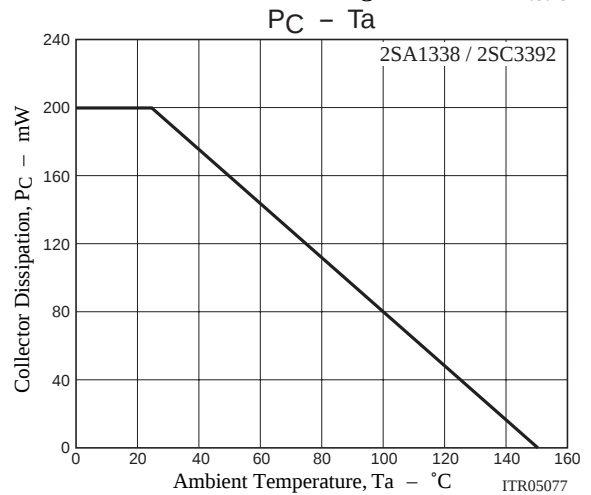
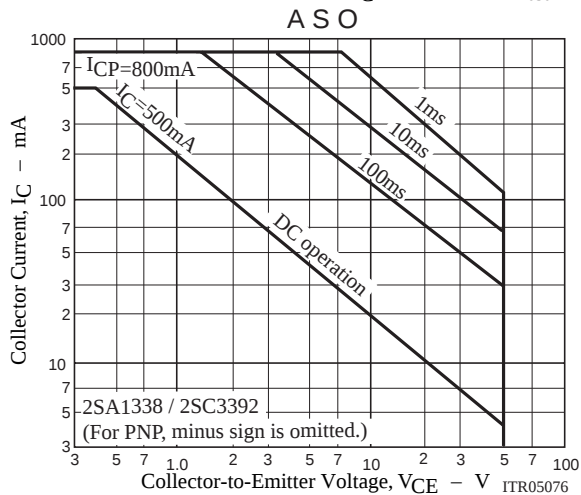
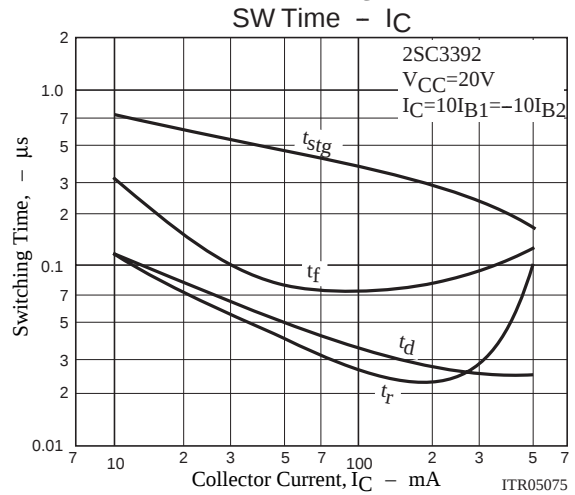
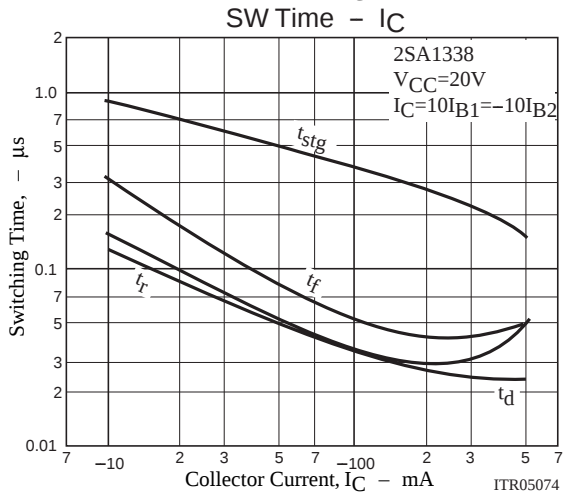
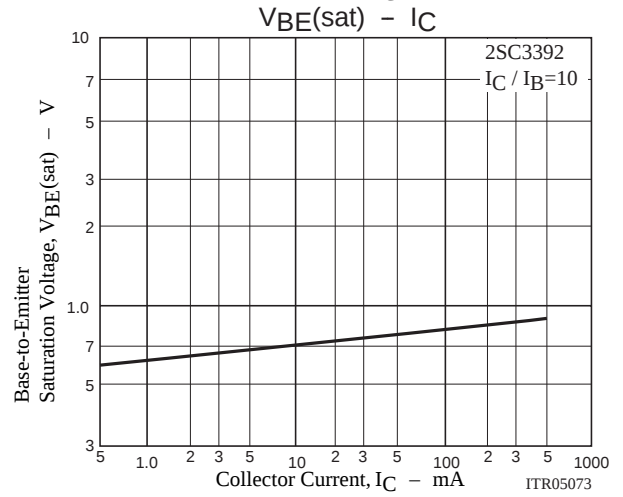
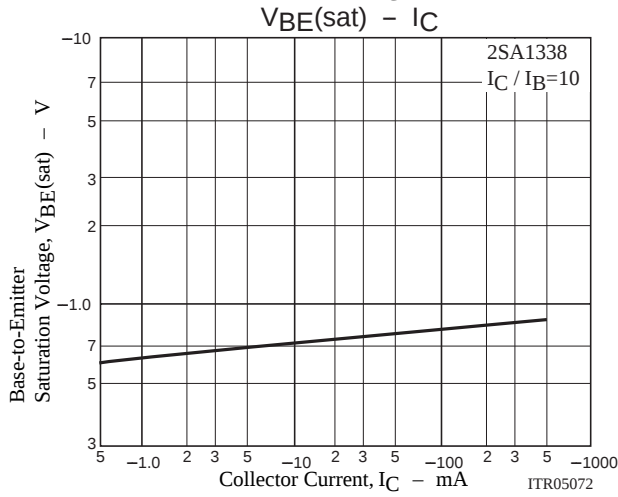
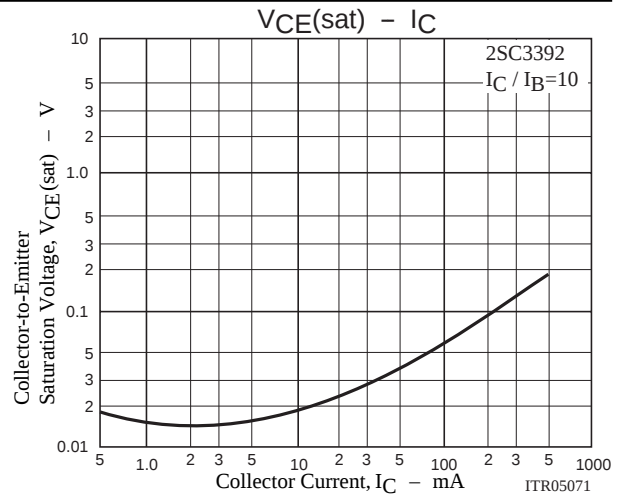
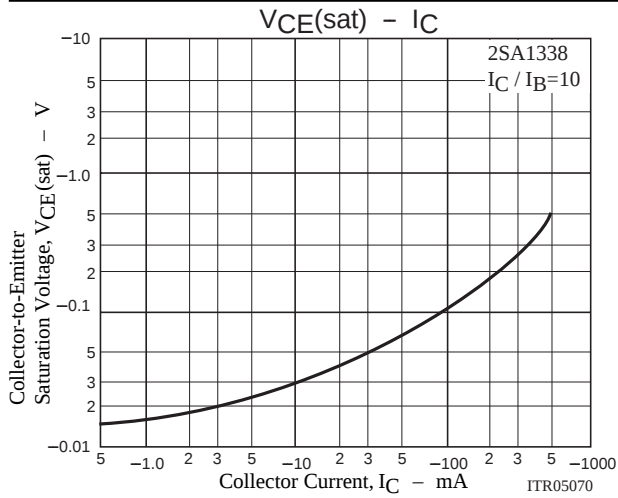
Switching Time Test Circuit
