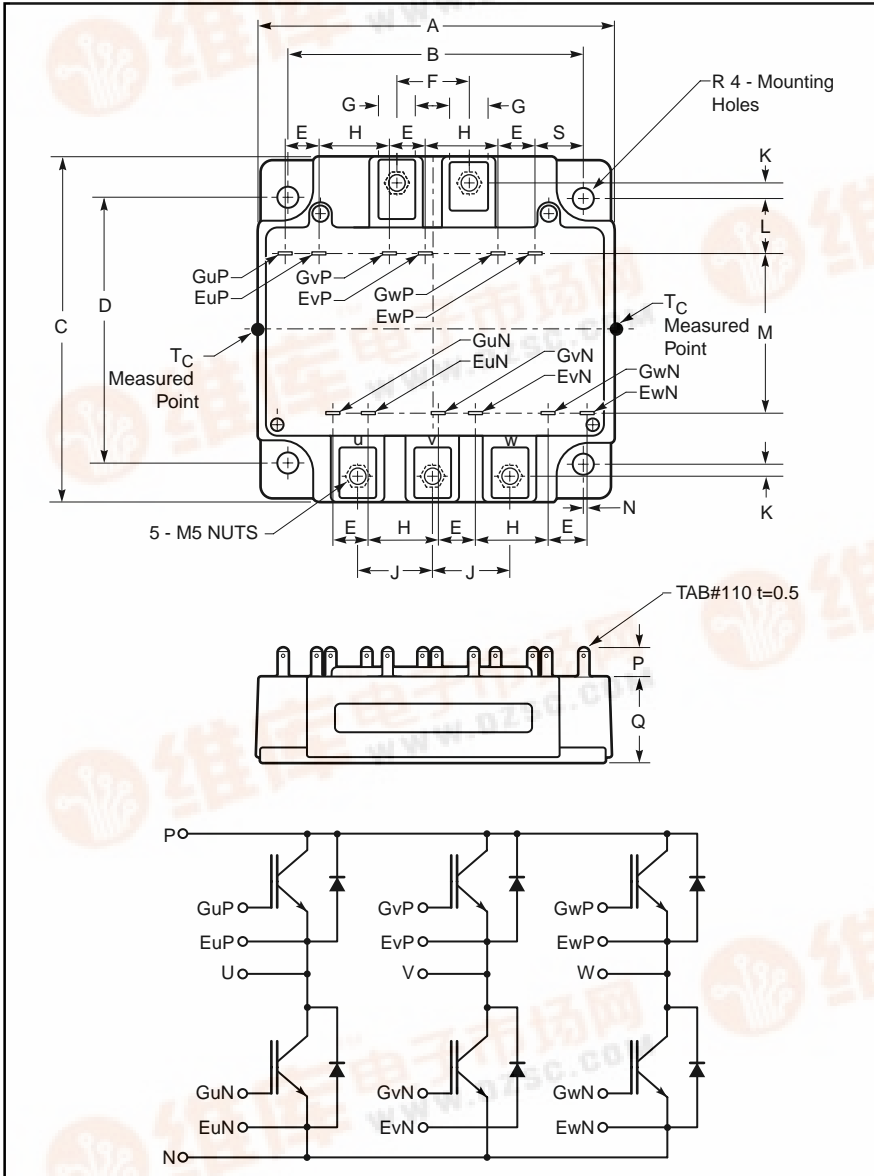


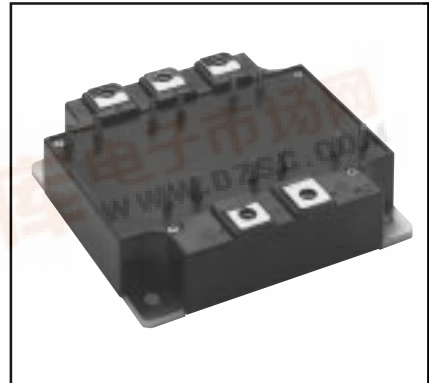

**Description:**

All components and interconnects are isolated from the heat sinking baseplate, offering simplified system assembly and thermal management.

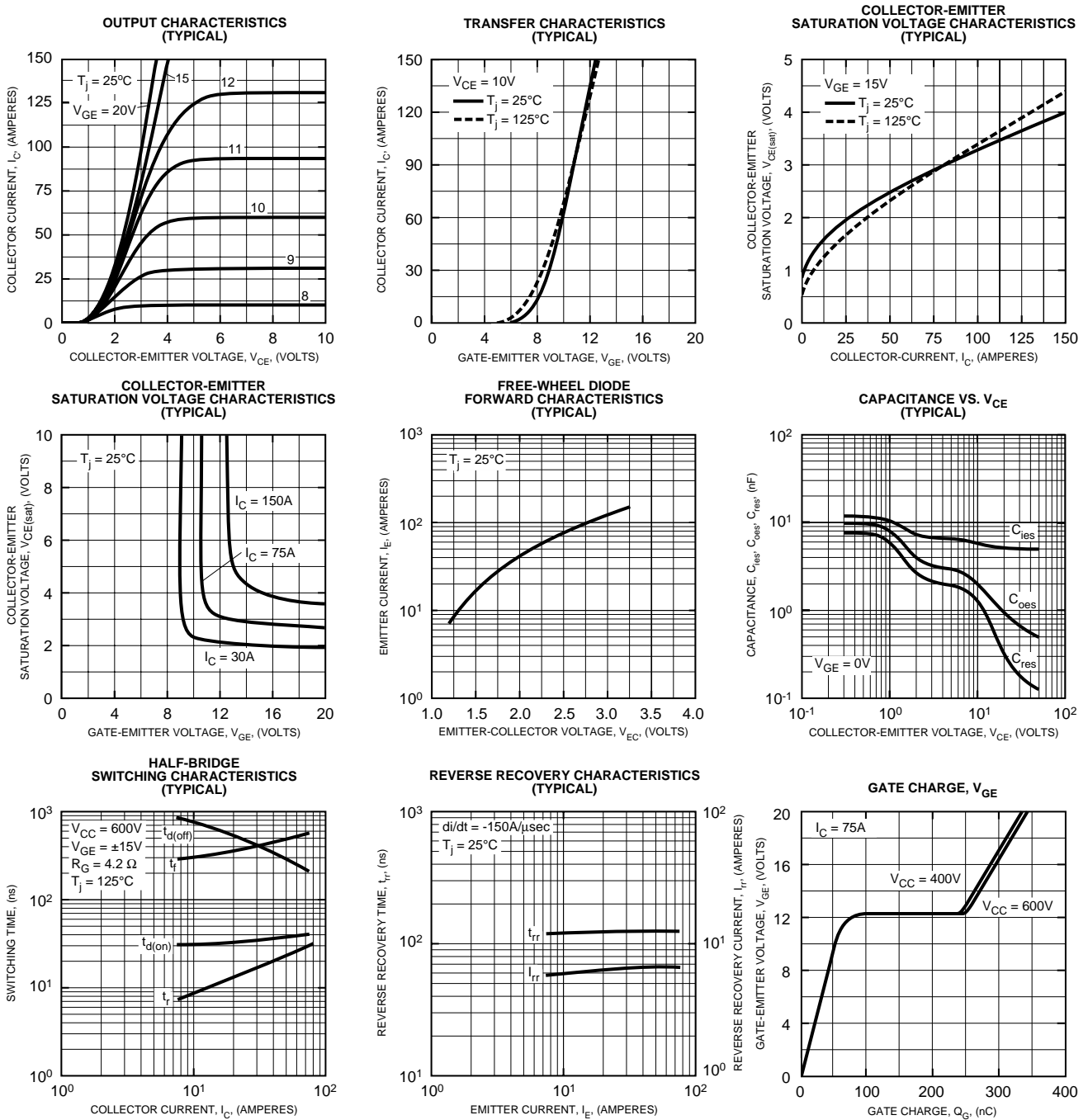
