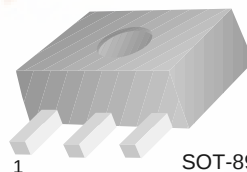

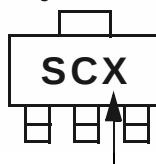

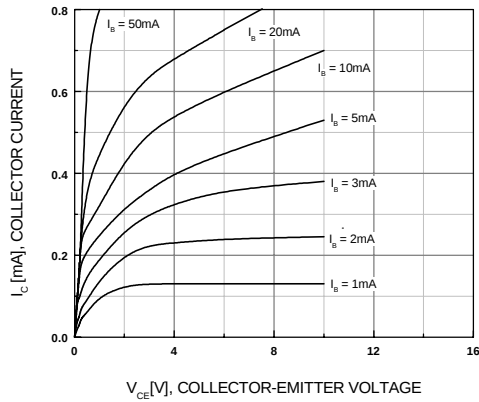


Figure 1. Static Characteristics

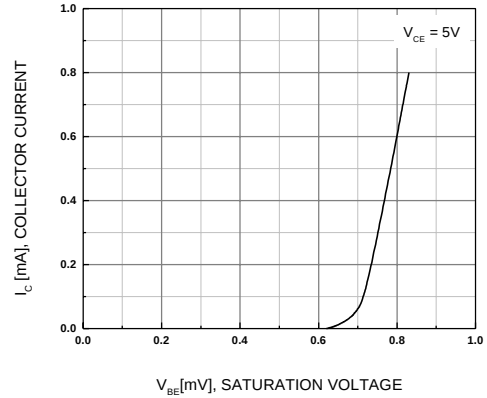


Figure 2. Base-Emitter On Voltage

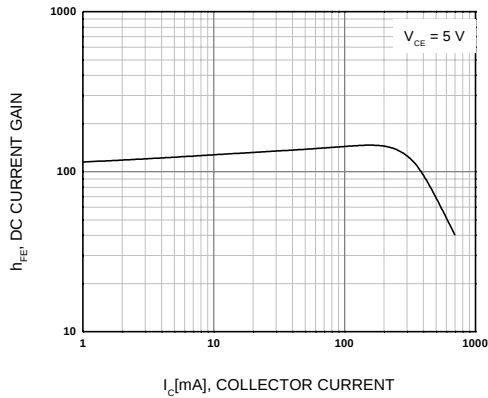


Figure 3. DC Current Gain

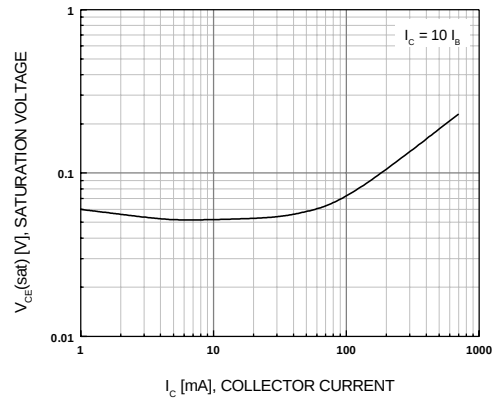


Figure 4. Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

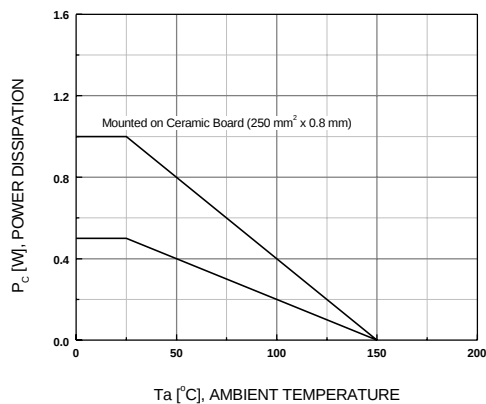


Figure 5. Power Derating

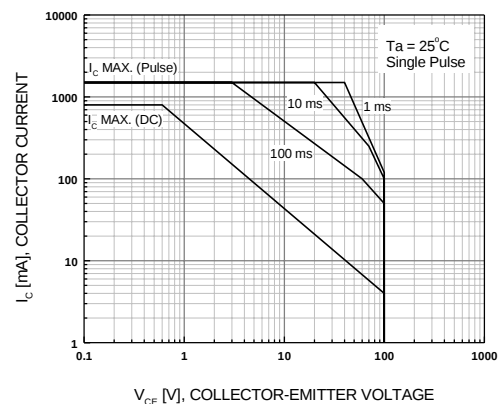
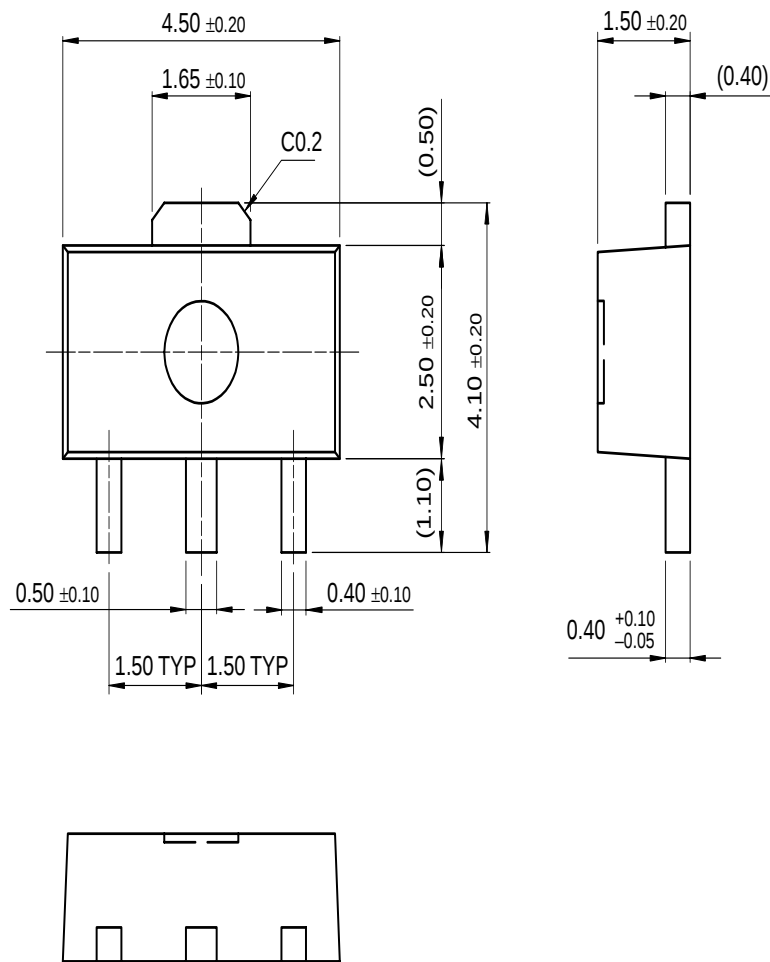


Figure 6. Safe Operating Area
