# **General Description**

The ISL9R1560G2, ISL9R1560P2, ISL9R1560S2 and ISL9R1560S3S are Stealth™ diodes optimized for low loss performance in high frequency hard switched applications. The Stealth™ family exhibits low reverse recovery current (I<sub>RM(REC)</sub>) and exceptionally soft recovery under typical operating conditions.

This device is intended for use as a free wheeling or boost diode in power supplies and other power switching applications. The low  $I_{RM(REC)}$  and short  $t_a$  phase reduce loss in switching transistors. The soft recovery minimizes ringing, expanding the range of conditions under which the diode may be operated without the use of additional snubber circuitry. Consider using the Stealth  $^{\rm TM}$  diode with an SMPS IGBT to provide the most efficient and highest power density design at lower cost.

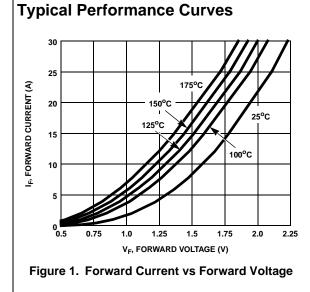

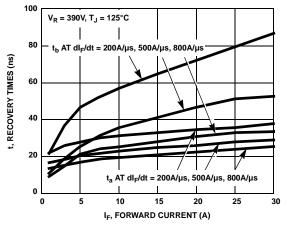


Figure 3.  $t_a$  and  $t_b$  Curves vs Forward Current

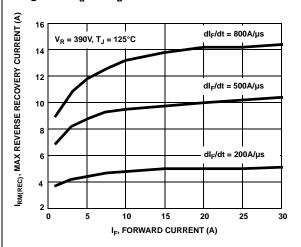


Figure 5. Maximum Reverse Recovery Current vs Forward Current

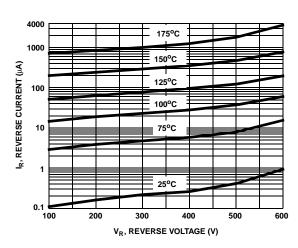


Figure 2. Reverse Current vs Reverse Voltage

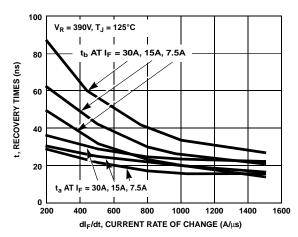


Figure 4.  $t_a$  and  $t_b$  Curves vs  $dI_F/dt$ 

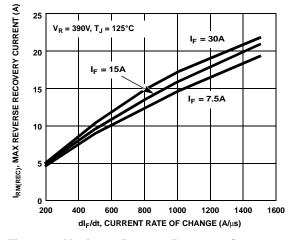


Figure 6. Maximum Reverse Recovery Current vs dl<sub>F</sub>/dt

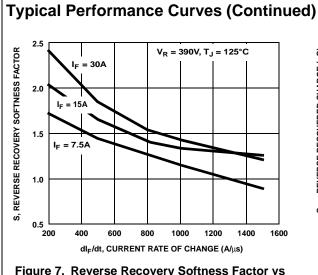


Figure 7. Reverse Recovery Softness Factor vs  $dl_F/dt$ 

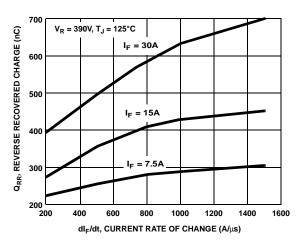


Figure 8. Reverse Recovered Charge vs  $dI_F/dt$ 

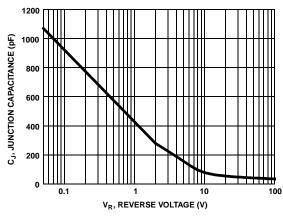


Figure 9. Junction Capacitance vs Reverse Voltage

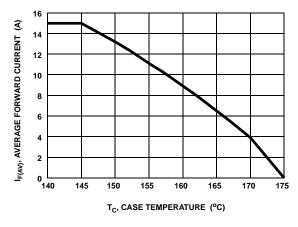


Figure 10. DC Current Derating Curve

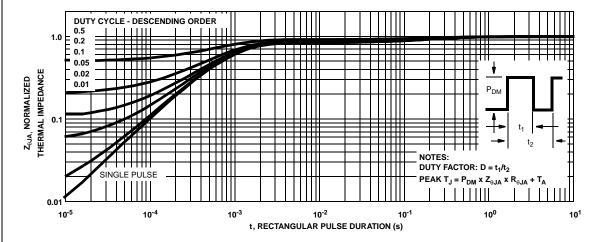
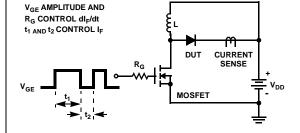


Figure 11. Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance

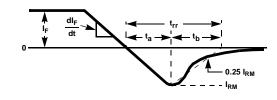


Figure 12. t<sub>rr</sub> Test Circuit

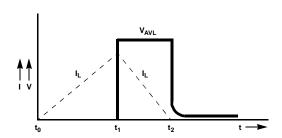


Figure 14. Avalanche Energy Test Circuit
