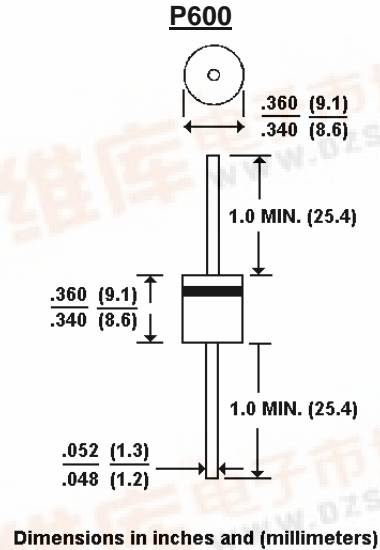

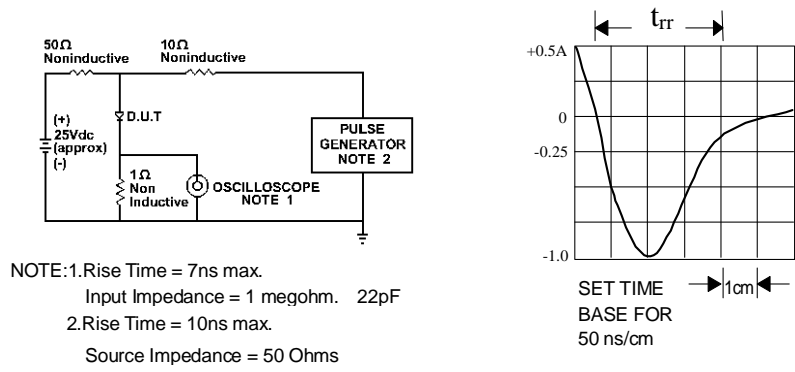


Fig. 1-REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM

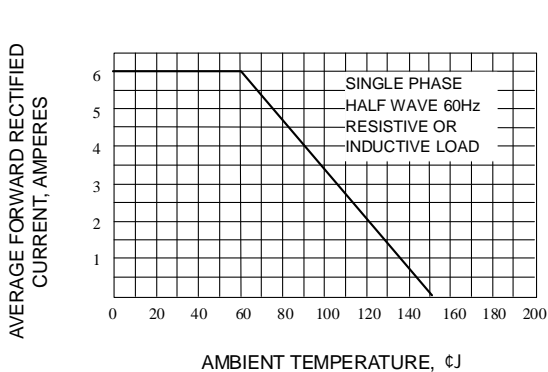


Fig. 2-FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

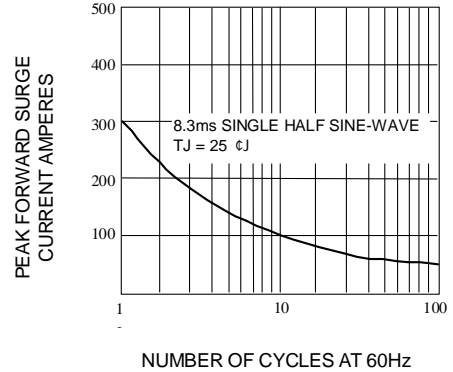


Fig. 3-FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE

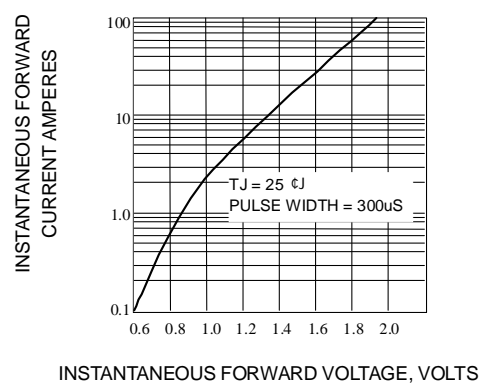


Fig. 4-TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTIC
