

## **DESCRIPTION/ORDERING INFORMATION**

This configurable multiple-function gate is designed for 1.65-V to 5.5-V V<sub>CC</sub> operation.

The SN74LVC1G58 features configurable multiple functions. The output state is determined by eight patterns of 3-bit input. The user can choose the logic functions AND, OR, NAND, NOR, XOR, inverter, and noninverter. All inputs can be connected to V<sub>CC</sub> or GND.

This device functions as an independent gate, but because of Schmitt action, it may have different input threshold levels for positive-going  $(V_{T+})$  and negative-going  $(V_{T-})$  signals.








Figure 4. 2-Input OR Gate




Figure 5. 2-Input XOR Gate
