Functional Description

The FCT2652T consists of bus transceiver circuits, D-type flip-flops, and control circuitry arranged for multiplexed trans-


8-Bit Registered Transceiver


mission of data directly from the input bus or from the internal storage registers. GAB and $\overline{\text{GBA}}$ control pins are provided to control the transceiver functions. SAB and SBA control pins are provided to select either real-time or stored data transfer.

The circuitry used for select control will eliminate the typical decoding glitch that occurs in a multiplexer during transition between stored and real-time data. A LOW input level selects real-time data and a HIGH selects stored data. Data on the A or B data bus, or both, can be stored in the internal D flip-flops by LOW-to-HIGH transitions at the appropriate clock pins (CPAB or CPBA), regardless of the select or enable control pins. When SAB and SBA are in the real-time transfer mode, it is also possible to store data without using the internal D-type flip-flops by simultaneously enabling GAB and GBA. In this configuration, each output reinforces its input. Thus, when all other data sources to the two sets of bus lines are at high impedance, each set of bus lines will remain at its last state.

On-chip termination resistors are added to the outputs to reduce system noise caused by reflections. The FCT2652T can replace the FCT652T to reduce noise in existing designs.

The outputs are designed with a power-off disable feature to allow for live insertion of boards

Notes:

The data output functions may be enabled or disabled by various signals at the GAB or GBA inputs. Data input functions are always enabled, i.e., data at the bus pins will be stored on every LOW-to-HIGH transition on the clock inputs.

Unless otherwise noted, these limits are over the operating free-air temperature range.

Unused inputs must always be connected to an appropriate logic voltage level, preferably either V_{CC} or ground.

Unused inputs must always be connected to an appropriate logic voltage level, preferably either V_{CC} or ground. Typical values are at V_{CC} =5.0V, T_A =+25°C ambient. This parameter is specified but not tested. Not more than one output should be shorted at a time. Duration of short should not exceed one second. The use of high-speed test apparatus and/or sample and hold techniques are preferable in order to minimize internal chip heating and more accurately reflect operational values. Otherwise prolonged shorting of a high output may raise the chip temperature well above normal and thereby cause invalid readings in other parametric tests. In any sequence of parameter tests, I_{OS} tests should be performed last.






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Package Diagrams
