




CASE 369AA DPAK (Surface Mount) STYLE 2

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



Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics

Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics







Figure 3. On–Resistance versus Drain Current and Temperature

Figure 4. On-Resistance versus Drain Current and Temperature






Figure 5. On–Resistance Variation with Temperature

Figure 6. Drain-to-Source Leakage Current versus Voltage




Figure 7. Capacitance Variation




Figure 8. Gate-to-Source and Drain-to-Source Voltage versus Total Charge




Figure 9. Resistive Switching Time Variation versus Gate Resistance




Figure 10. Diode Forward Voltage versus Current




Figure 11. Maximum Rated Forward Biased Safe Operating Area




Figure 12. Thermal Response
