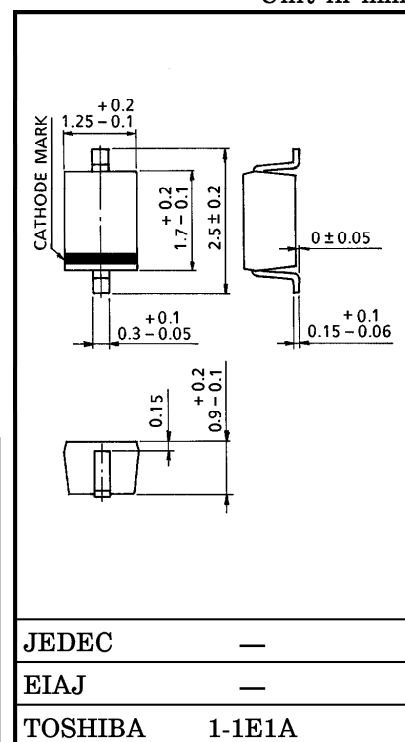

Unit in mm

- Two-pin small packages are suitable for higher mounting densities.
- Excellent in Forward Current and Forward Voltage Characteristics : $V_F(2) = 0.90 \text{ V (Typ.)}$
- Fast Reverse Recovery Time : $t_{rr} = 60 \text{ ns (Typ.)}$
- Small Total Capacitance : $C_T = 1.5 \text{ pF (Typ.)}$
